Your timing belt should be replaced every 50,000–70,000 miles, depending on your car's make and model. Also, make sure you understand if your engine is an interference engine or a non-interference engine. In an interference engine, the valves and piston share the same airspace and the timing belt keeps them from touching. This is why you'll have a major engine failure on your hands if the belt breaks or skips.

When should I change the timing belt on my 2003 Mazda MX-5 ...

To change a timing chain, remove the radiator cap, drain the coolant out, and remove the radiator hoses. Next, remove the drive belt components before unbolting the timing chain cover. Then, line the bright links on the timing chain up with the marks on your camshaft and crankshaft gears to get your engine to top dead center.

I have just had it serviced by Kwik Fit (great value and service by the way), and they flagged that the timing belt will need changing shortly. This is recommended at six years old or 56,000 miles. My car has done 47,000 miles.
